- 1 If an error is made by Nottingham City Council or your Bank or Building Society, you are guaranteed a full and immediate refund from your branch of the amount paid.
- 1 You can cancel a Direct Debit at any time by writing to your Bank or Building Society. Please also send a copy of your letter to us.
