

Help the development of a new sexual violence and abuse service in Nottingham City

The Nottingham Crime and Drugs Partnership commissioned a new service on behalf of the Nottingham Domestic and Sexual Violence and Abuse Joint Commissioning Group. The new service launched in April 2016

An advisory group has identified six groups where the service would like to develop its knowledge and understanding. The CDP and the service are committed to continuous development and co-production of the service.

The groups are:

- Disabled people and those with learning difficulties
- The lesbian, gay, bisexual and transgender communities
- Survivors of historic and institutional and historic abuse
- Refugees (including war rape and corrective rape)
- Men who have sex with men and use substances (CHEMSEX)
- Survivors of rape in prison
