

DRAFT DETERMINATION FOR AN A2 INSTALLATION

Date of Advert: 2 July 2007

**Pollution Prevention and Control (England and Wales) Regulations 2000: SI 1973
(as amended)**

Polestar UK Print Ltd. – Chromoworks

(1) Nottingham City Council as the regulator has made a draft determination upon the application from the company known as Polestar Print UK Ltd. whose address is Marlborough Court, Sunrise Parkway, Linford Wood, Milton Keynes MK14 6DY for a permit to operate an installation undertaking heatset web offset printing with an organic solvent consumption of greater than 200 tonnes per year at Polestar UK Print Ltd. – Chromoworks, Wigman Rd, Aspley, Nottingham NG8 3JA.

(2) The Council has published the draft determination on the public register. Members of the public are able to view the public register free of charge. It is held at

(3) The public register contains the following information about this application:

- A 'decision document', which gives the reasons, and considerations on which the Council has made the draft determination.

End date for representations: **27 July 2007**

(5) If the Council does not receive any representations from the public, the Council's decision will be made final and the applicant will be notified **within 5 working days** of the end of the period for representations.

(6) If the Council does receive representations, the Council's decision will be finalised and notified to the applicant and to the public by means of the Nottingham City Council website and by letter to the applicant and any responders, **within 15 working days** of the end of the period for representations or a longer period as the Council may agree with the applicant.
