6

babies a year die in an unsafe sleep environment across Nottingham City and County, including Bassetlaw

41.6%

babies known to Social Care at the time of their death

70.6%

babies were in an unsafe sleep environment

27.5%

one or both parents had taken a drug which could make them drowsy, either prescribed or illegal

Increase

in un-recommended sleep products being used Pods/nests, pillows, cot bumpers, hammocks and sleep positioners

85.3%

babies aged 6 months or less

77.8%

had Parental Smoking

Increase

in incidence of sofa sleeping – either baby alone or co sleeping

20.6%

One or both parents had been drinking alcohol



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
