<p>OFSTED INSPECTION CYCLE Newly registered providers on the Early Years Register will usually be inspected within the first 30 months of registration, and then will be re-inspected within a 6 year window from their last inspection. Settings with an inadequate judgement will be re-inspected within 6 months. Settings with a requires improvement will be re-inspected within 12 months.</p>
