Notification of Disclosable Pecuniary Interests and Other Registerable Interests for inclusion in the Register of Councillors' Interests

Councillors have a statutory duty to register and disclose any Disclosable Pecuniary Interests and Other Registerable Interests through the completion of a Register of Interests.

Your Register of Interests will be retained by the Council for the period during which you are a Councillor, and for 3 years after you cease to be a Councillor. Your Register of Interests will be published on the Council's website and available for public inspection during the period for which you are a Councillor. Interests declared at formal meetings of the Council will be recorded in the Minutes of that meeting. Minutes of public meetings are kept in perpetuity as a record of decision-making by the Council. It is your responsibility to ensure that the information provided on your Register of Interests is accurate and kept up-to-date.

Notification of Disclosable Pecuniary Interests - Holders of public office must avoid placing themselves under any obligation to people or organisations that might try inappropriately to influence them in their work. They should not act or take decisions in order to gain financial or other material benefits for themselves, their family, or their friends. Your registration of personal interests should be guided by this duty. A person's pecuniary interests are their business interests (for example their employment, trade, profession, contracts, or any company with which they are associated) and wider financial interests they might have (for example trust funds, investments, and assets including land and property). Remember that most of these apply to your partner as well as to you where you are aware of your partner's interest.

Other Registerable Interests

So that Councillors can register interests not included above, but which would constitute Other Registerable Interests, and to promote transparency, it is recommended that co-opted members complete this section, if applicable.

A co-opted member has a personal interest in any business of the Council where it relates to or is likely to affect:

- (a) any body of which they are in general control or management, and to which they are nominated or appointed by the Council;
- (b) any body in which they have a financial interest or a management or decision-making role, and which exercises functions of a public nature; is directed to charitable purposes; or has a principal purpose that includes the influence of public opinion or policy (including any political party or trade union).
- (c) any body of which they are a member that is a private club or society, such as the Freemasons, a recreational club, working men's club or private investment club.
