**Appendix 1 applies ONLY from Warm Home Fund applicants where First Time Central Heating.**

Installing first time central heating, and potentially a first time gas connections is an expensive home energy improvement, which is unaffordable for many low income households. Yet for households off the gas network and/or without central heating they are likely to be using more expensive alternatives of heating.

This makes such homes “high cost” to heat and will be reflected in their Energy Performance Certificates which for LAFlex eligibility purposes under Warm Homes Fund will be D, E, F or G.

Nottingham City Council wishes to focus resources on affected areas by widening the LAFlex eligibility criteria under Warm Homes Fund to a gross household income in the table below:

Applicants will be assessed by Eon, Nottinghamshire Warm Home Fund installer. Applicants will be asked if they meet the household eligibility criteria and give permission that their data can be shared with Council, agencies working on the project and contractors, in accordance with GDPR regulations.

The Council retains the right to use its discretion where household eligibility criteria is not fully met if the withholding of support would make that household particularly vulnerable.

**Evidence and Monitoring**

Nottingham City Council will use its discretion on whether any auditing is required to confirm eligibility under this statement of intent. If any auditing is undertaken it will be through random sample checks post installation.

**Appendix 2 applies ONLY where includes a First Time Gas Connection as part of Warm Home Fund.**

**Nottingham City Council have identified streets which have never had gas connections and residents rely upon expensive forms of alternative heating leading to poor levels of affordable warmth and resident fuel poverty. These residents would benefit from the gas mains extending as part of Warm Homes Fund initiative.**
