

**CONSENT UNDER ARTICLE 4 (1) (b) OF THE NOTTINGHAM CITY COUNCIL
DOGS EXCLUSION PUBLIC SPACES PROTECTION ORDER 2016**

**(ANTI-SOCIAL BEHAVIOUR, CRIME AND POLICING ACT 2014, CHAPTER 2,
SECTION 59-75)**

In accordance with Article 4(1)(b) of the Nottingham City Council Dogs Exclusion Public Spaces Protection Order 2016 ("the Order") Nottingham City Council, being the owner occupier or authority having control of the areas designated as sites of special scientific interest and/or local nature reserves within their administrative area and listed in the Schedule below ("the Land") where dogs are excluded in accordance with the Order, HEREBY CONSENTS to dogs entering and remaining on the Land ("the Consent") PROVIDED THAT the Person in Charge of each dog or dogs ("the Dog") which enters and remains on the Land pursuant to the Consent complies forthwith with a direction given by an Authorised Officer of the Authority to put and keep the Dog on a lead ("the Condition").

Failure to comply with the Condition WILL RESULT IN THE IMMEDIATE WITHDRAWAL OF CONSENT FOR THE DOG ENTERING AND REMAINING ON THE LAND and the Person in Charge of the Dog will be guilty of an offence under Article 4(1) of the Order UNLESS he has a reasonable excuse for failing to do so. The Person in Charge of the dog may also be in breach of other Public Spaces Protection Orders and/or other legislation.

For the purpose of the Consent and the Condition 'Person in Charge' shall have the same meaning as that given in the Order and 'Authorised Officer of the Authority' shall have the same meaning as that given in the Nottingham City Council Dogs on Leads by Direction Public Spaces Protection Order 2016.

Nottingham City Council reserves the right to withdraw the Consent in relation to the Land, or in relation to parts thereof at any time, or on times and dates specified. Any such withdrawal of consent will be published at www.nottinghamcity.gov.uk and will also be advertised on the Land or the part thereof affected.
