We will use the information provided by you for monitoring of the highways network, and analysis of raw traffic data to assist with the improvement of traffic flow. The basis under which the Council uses personal data for this purpose is that this is necessary for meeting the Council's legal obligations under the Traffic Management Act 2004

The information provided by you includes the following special categories of personal data: CCTV video footage of identifiable persons and still images of persons. Information in these categories is used by the Council on the basis that such use is necessary for reasons of substantial public interest, and in accordance with the provisions of the Data Protection Act 2018

The information that you have provided will be kept for 31 days, or until completion of any investigations that require video footage to be retained for an additional period.

The information provided by you may also be used for the purpose of any other function carried out by the Council. Information about these functions and the legal basis on which information is used for them can be found at http://documents.nottinghamcity.gov.uk/download/5939.

The General Data Protection Regulation 2016/679 and the Data Protection Act 2018 provides for the following rights as prescribed by the legislation:

- A right to request a copy of your information
- A right to request rectification of inaccurate personal data
- A right to request erasure of your data known as 'the right to be forgotten'
- A right to in certain circumstances to request restriction of processing
- A right in certain circumstances to request portability of your data to another provider
- A right to object to processing of data in certain circumstances

• A right regarding automated decision making including profiling
