Forest School Approach

Childminder, Katy Burgess, runs a setting in West Bridgford, Nottinghamshire, where she has developed a fantastic approach to using natural local spaces.

On Saturday 22nd March, she was joined by over **20 childminders** from the Hub community at Skylarks Nature Reserve to share her expertise on adopting the Forest School approach to transform natural spaces into rich learning environments.

Katy shared how this child-centred approach has promoted **independence**, **resilience** and **confidence** with her minded children. The outdoor settings can also be great for "getting back to the basics of learning, as the highly sensory environment is known to improve social interactions, progress problem solving and spatial awareness, as well as develop gross & fine motor skills."



- Learn how to respond in a safe way
- Know how to refer children and adults for support, and understand the process
- Expand your knowledge of safeguarding
- Learn simple techniques which may help reduce the impact of living with domestic abuse in the 0 5 years age range
