Job title: Asset Data Analyst

1. Job purpose

The Asset Data Analyst is responsible for processing, analysing, and interpreting data related to the company's stock and financial assets. This role involves ensuring the accuracy, integrity, and usability of asset data to support strategic decision-making and operational efficiency. The ideal candidate will possess strong analytical skills, attention to detail, and proficiency in data management and analysis tools.

2. Principal duties and responsibilities

1. Collect, validate, and maintain asset data from various sources.
2. Develop and enforce data governance policies and standards to ensure data quality and consistency.
3. Administer and update asset databases and systems to reflect accurate and current information.
4. To produce accurate reports using in house systems to produce data in a meaningful and accurate presentation.
5. Analyse asset data to identify trends, patterns, and insights that drive business decisions and Capital investment.
6. Conduct regular audits and reconciliations to ensure data accuracy and completeness.
7. Use statistical and analytical tools to interpret complex data sets. To act as the first point of contact for asset performance and data analysis.
8. Generate and distribute regular and ad-hoc reports on asset performance, utilization, and lifecycle.
9. Create dashboards and visualisations to present data insights to a range of stakeholders.
10. Prepare detailed documentation and reports to support management and strategic planning.
11. Identify opportunities to streamline data collection, management, and analysis processes.



- 12. Implement best practices for data management and analysis.
- 13. Recommend and implement improvements to asset management practices based on data insights.
- 14. Work closely with Data Analytics Manager around finance, operations, IT, and other departments to gather and validate asset data.
- 15. Collaborate with cross-functional teams to ensure data alignment and consistency across the organization.
