

## **Public Space Closed Circuit Television (CCTV) Evaluation - 1<sup>st</sup> January to 31<sup>st</sup> December 2025**

### **Description of the Scheme and the Geographical Area(s) of Operation**

Public space CCTV provision is an effective tool available to local authorities and their partnerships to address crime, anti-social behaviour and improve security. Local authorities as responsible authorities under the provisions of the Crime and Disorder Act 1998 (and as amended) have a responsibility, not only to develop community safety plans but also to consider the impact of all their policies on crime, anti-social behaviour, substance misuse and reoffending.

Nottingham City Council provides a comprehensive range of services across the public safety spectrum, which include Community Protection enforcement, housing enforcement, licensing and cleansing. The Nottingham Control Centre based at Woodlands in Radford manages the public space cameras of Nottingham City Council. There are 303 public space cameras covering Nottingham City; 288 of these are monitored continuously with operatives in direct communication with Nottinghamshire Police. The remaining 15 CCTV Cameras require the operator to dial into the camera to view and airtime is used to be able to undertake live viewings. All cameras are recording 24/7 for the required 31 days.

Under the Surveillance Camera Commissioner: Code of Practice<sup>1</sup> it is a requirement that:

- Surveillance camera system images and information should be subject to appropriate security measures to safeguard against unauthorised access and use.
- There should be effective review and audit mechanisms to ensure legal requirements, policies and standards are complied with in practice, and regular reports should be published.
- When the use of a surveillance camera system is in pursuit of a legitimate aim, and there is a pressing need for its use, it should then be used in the most effective way to support public safety and law enforcement with the aim of processing images and information of evidential value.
- Any information used to support a surveillance camera system which compares against a reference database for matching purposes should be accurate and kept up to date.

The Control Centre within the Woodlands meets all of the requirements above, which are annually audited as part of holding the following accreditations and compliances:

- BS 7958:2015 Code of Practice for the Management and Operation of CCTV
- ISO 9001: 2015
- BS 7858 Security Vetting
- BS 5979 – Alarm Receiving Centre
- Fully compliant with Surveillance Camera Code of Practice (2013)

There are two configurations to the public space CCTV:

1. *Permanently installed cameras* - which are hard wired into a leased analogue/fibre provider (such as BT, Virgin)
2. SIM technology to transmit images back to the operator using data allowance

In addition to the core public space CCTV stock, there are 15 4G Redeployable cameras that wards have purchased in previous years to address local anti-social behaviour (ASB) and Fly-Tipping (Environmental) issues. The table below shows where they are currently located:

The 4G Redeployable cameras managed by the CCTV control room, which are placed for short-term solutions in response to ward or police requests.

### **The Objective and Scope of the Scheme:**

The following purposes have been established, and notification has been registered with the Information Commissioner for the Nottingham City CCTV and associated systems:

Initiatives under the crime & disorder act including participation in crime reduction partnerships, serving of anti-social behaviour orders etc.

Operation of CCTV systems in Public Spaces, housing estates, council premises where the object is the prevention and detection of crime and community safety programmes.

Note. This purpose is designed to describe general crime prevention initiatives. More specific activities, for instance the investigation and prosecution of cases of benefit fraud are recorded under the relevant purposes.

Nottingham City Council and partners support the individual's right to privacy and will insist that all agencies involved in the provision and use of Public CCTV systems connected to the Nottingham City Council's CCTV Control Centre accept this fundamental principle as being paramount. Before cameras are placed in residential areas the residents in that area will be consulted concerning the proposed system. The results of the consultation will be considered as part of the completed Data Protection Privacy Impact Assessment (DPIA).

The public interest in the operation of the scheme will be recognised by ensuring the security and integrity of operational procedures.

The system will continue to be operated by trained and authorised personnel.

The scheme aims to provide surveillance of the public areas in order to fulfil the purposes of the scheme. The area protected by CCTV is indicated by the presence of signs. The signs are placed so that the public are aware that they are entering a zone, which is covered by surveillance equipment. The signs state the organisation responsible for the scheme, the purposes of the scheme and a contact telephone number. Data will not be held for longer than necessary and disposal of information will be regulated.

The scheme is registered with the Information Commissioner. The registration number is **Z5833067**. The scheme will be managed in accordance with the principles of the Data Protection Act 1998, Human Rights Act 1998, and all other relevant legislation. Reviews of Data Protection and Legal Requirements are taken annually.

Includes use of closed-circuit television for the monitoring and collection of visual images for the purpose of maintaining the security of premises, for preventing crime and investigating crime.

**The Operation:**

CCTV Cameras are monitored by Nottingham Control Centre 24 hours a day 365 days a year by trained staff who have been screened in accordance with British Standard 7858 and NPPV Level 2.

All employees engaged in the monitoring and operation of CCTV have received training to the standards required by the Private Security Industry Act 2001. As a further requirement of the above Act all operators are licensed by the Security Industry Authority (SIA).

In addition to the live feed cameras, the CCTV scheme has a stock of 15 redeployable cameras. These are placed in areas identified as having high levels of Anti-Social Behaviour and Fly-Tipping/ Environmental related incident. During 2025, 26 reactive viewings took place of these 4G style cameras, of which 20 of these viewings were taken as footage. Management of these cameras and their placement is through a partnership forum; attendees include police, street scene, and community protection. The impact of these cameras is very direct in that they often disperse the crime from the original area of concern.

**Data Protection Impact Assessments & Subject Access Requests:**


During 2025, there were 12 Data Protection Impact Assessments completed to support the installation of the CCTV cameras.

## **REVIEWS UNDERTAKEN BY POLICE AND EXTERNAL AGENCIES**

In total the Control centre had 2780 viewings of which 2306 of these resulting in footage being taken as evidence. The highest proportion of viewing requests are related to 'Crime - Violence Against Person' & 'Robbery/ Theft' related incidents.

We utilise Cryptshare and NICE to securely send over most of the CCTV footage requests. Of which, 83% of CCTV Footage is requested by the Police & Partner Agencies. Since the introduction of encrypted transfer files, which are sent electronically, evidential footage has increased twofold.

The Control Centre processed 1 Subject Access requests on the systems that is monitored within the CCTV Control Centre.



### **The Aims and Objectives for the Next 12 Months:**

We still continue to install a replacement programme for our ageing stock which will over a rolling 12-month period resulting in 10% of our stock being replaced with newer IP cameras as we move away from analogue. The advantages of IP are clear to see giving higher video quality than analogue cameras and offer more video site range, such as wide or narrow field of view and better zoom in quality.

Within NCC Housing Services and NCC Waste Services, the team have identified the need for seven redeployable CCTV cameras to effectively address issues of antisocial behaviour (ASB) and fly-tipping. (Housing Services are purchasing 4 cameras, and Waste Services are purchasing 3 cameras).

These CCTV cameras also have ANPR (Automatic Number Plate Recognition) technology, enhancing the ability to identify vehicles involved in environmental crime. The proposed deployment includes the integration of a PTZ camera as well as three static units, providing a combination of wide-area monitoring and fixed-point coverage.

These cameras were successfully trialled in 2025, delivering positive outcomes across multiple Nottingham wards. During the trial, the technology contributed to the detection of fly-tipping offences, resulting in Fixed Penalty Notices (FPNs) being issued to the individuals responsible.

Within the last year, we have received feedback from our existing help points and found that their inconsistencies within their appearance and re-designed Help Points, which are consistent in their appearance obvious to the public on what they are and all hard-wired back to the Woodlands CCTV Control Room. The first of these help points will be installed within the City Centre located on Long Row with plans to install two further help points in the Bulwell Ward, this is part of Regeneration Work.

As part of the planned upgrade of the CCTV Control Room, four specialist companies have been invited to submit designs and proposals for the full refurbishment on site. The scope of the planned improvements includes the modernisation of the CCTV video wall, replacement of operator workstations, and the installation of new, durable flooring to support a more efficient and professional working environment.

This procurement and design process is ongoing, with all submissions currently under consideration. Further evaluation and consultation will continue as part of the planning phase to ensure that the final design meets operational requirements and future-proofs the control room for emerging technologies.
