## Affordable Housing Contributions arising from Purpose Built Student Accommodation Supplementary Planning Document (SPD)

## **Adoption Statement**

In accordance with <u>The Town and Country Planning (Local Planning) (England)</u> <u>Regulations 2012</u> this statement gives notice that Nottingham City Council adopted the Affordable Housing Contributions arising from Purpose Built Student Accommodation Supplementary Planning Document (SPD) on **18 May 2021**. The SPD supplements Policy 8 of the <u>Aligned Core Strategy 2014</u> (ACS) and Policy HO3: Affordable Housing in the <u>Land and Planning Policies Local Plan Part 2 - 2020</u> (LAPP) to provide the policy basis for setting out affordable housing contributions from large Purpose Built Student Accommodation schemes.

Any person with sufficient interest in the decision to adopt the SPD may apply to the High Court for permission to apply for judicial review of that decision. Any such application for leave must be made promptly and in any event no later than three months after the date on which the SPD was adopted.
