

CRIMINAL JUSTICE AND POLICE ACT 2001, SECTION 13(2)

**THE NOTTINGHAM CITY COUNCIL (ALCOHOL CONSUMPTION
IN PUBLIC PLACES) DESIGNATION ORDER 2005**

The Nottingham City Council in exercise of the powers conferred by section 13(2) of the Criminal Justice and Police Act 2001 (in this Order called "the 2001 Act") hereby makes the following Order:-

1. The land described in the Schedule below and shown on the plan attached to this Order (in this Order called "the Plan"), being land in the area of Nottingham City Council which is land to which the 2001 Act applies, is hereby designated for the purposes of the 2001 Act.
2. This Order may be cited as the Nottingham City Council (Alcohol Consumption in Public Places) Designation Order 2005 and shall come into force on 1 September 2005.
3. By virtue of this Order and section 15(2) of the 2001 Act, the following byelaws shall on 1 September 2005 cease to have effect:
 - (i) Nottingham City Council Consumption of Intoxicating Liquor in Designated Places; and
 - (ii) Nottingham City Council Consumption of Intoxicating Liquor in the Victoria Centre Market and Sneinton Market; and
 - (iii) Nottingham City Centre Consumption of Intoxicating Liquor in Public Conveniences
4. "Public Place" means any place to which the public or any section of the public has access on payment or otherwise, as of right or by virtue of express or implied permission

SCHEDULE OF DESIGNATED PUBLIC PLACES

All places to which the public has access, namely all highways, squares, pedestrian areas, public conveniences, doorways, entrances and all other open areas within the boundary delineated by a thick black line on the Plan which shall include those places described in Parts 1 to 7 to this Schedule and in the event of a conflict between the Plan and the Parts to the Schedule the Plan shall have precedence

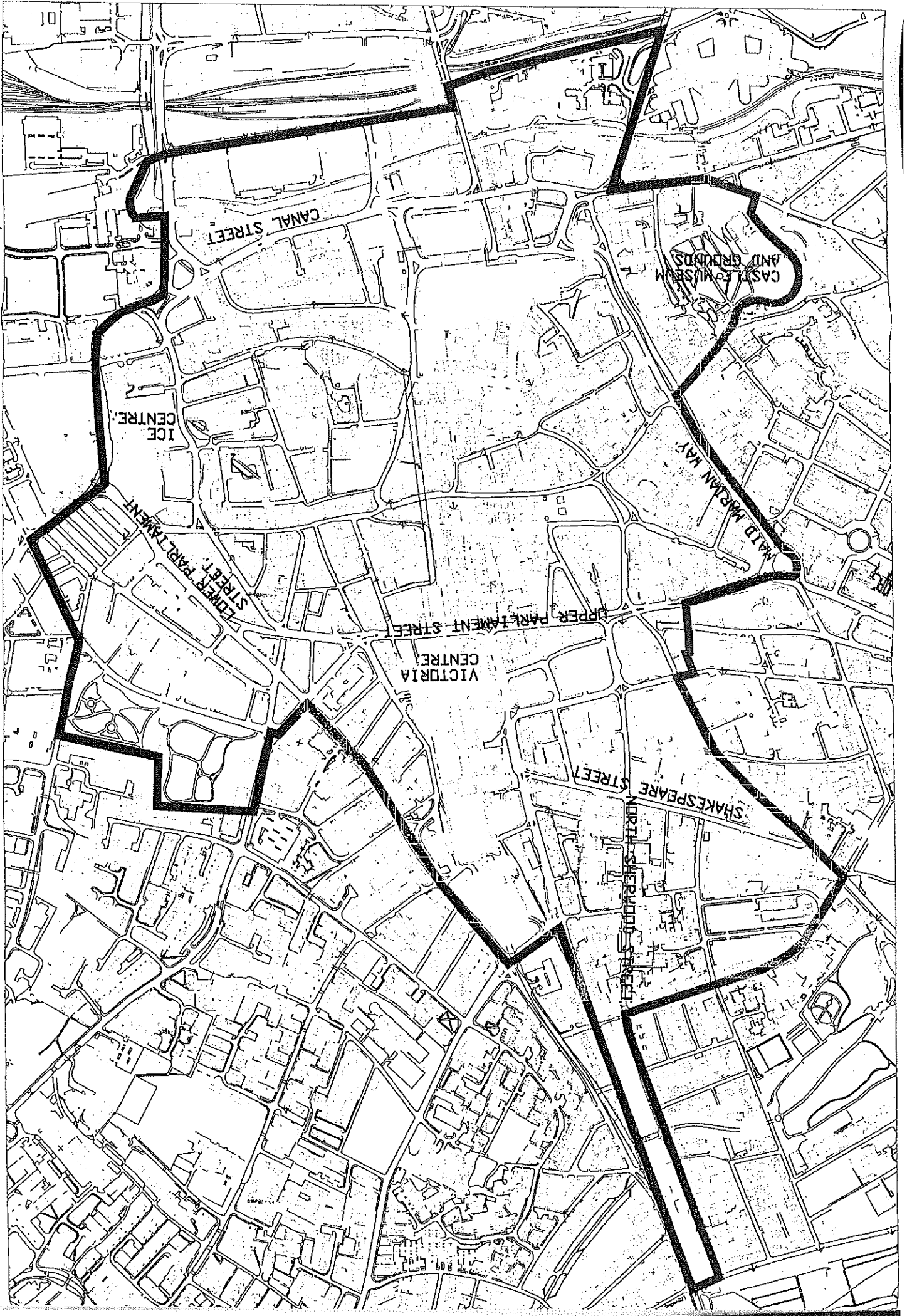

**(ANTI-SOCIAL BEHAVIOUR, CRIME AND POLICING ACT 2014, CHAPTER 2
SECTION 59 – 75)**

The Nottingham City Council (Alcohol Consumption in Public Places) Designation Order 2005 ('the Order') was made under section 13(2) of the Criminal Justice and Police Act 2001 ('2001 Act') and originally known as a Designated Public Place Order or 'DPPO'. Section 13(2) of the 2001 Act has now been repealed but pursuant to section 75 of the Anti-social Behaviour, Crime and Policing Act 2014 ('the 2014 Act') the Order remained in force until 20 October 2017, after which it continued to remain in force as if the provisions of the Order were provisions of a Public Spaces Protection Order ('PSPO') made under the 2014 Act.

Pursuant to section 60(2) of the 2014 Act the period that the Order has effect has been extended. This extension was approved by Executive Board on 21 July 2020. The Order will now expire on 18 October 2023.

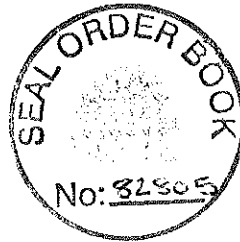
