If you are new to Nottingham the first point of contact would be The New Arrivals Coordinator (NCC asylum seeker and refugee support). This service is based in the Community Protection Directorate of Nottingham City Council.

This service responds to the needs of asylum seeker and refugee families. It helps you to access services and advice that will help your family to integrate.

Nottingham City Council is firmly committed to supporting new arrivals and will continue to work with asylum seeker and refugee families to build strong, integrated communities.


