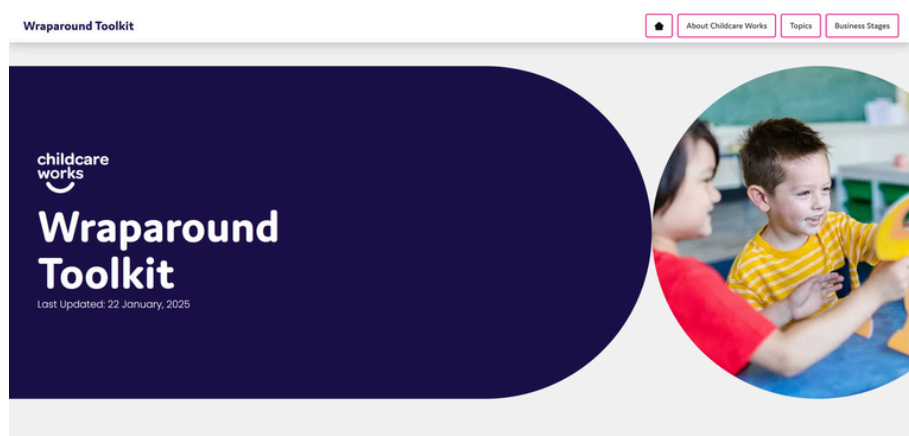




School Engagement with National Wraparound Childcare Programme: Checklist

How To Use This Checklist
