Adoption Statement

Notice is hereby given that, in accordance with regulation 14 of the Town and Country Planning (Local Planning)(England) Regulations 2012, Nottingham City Council adopted the Island Site Supplementary Planning Document (SPD) on 19 April 2016.

The Island Site Supplementary Planning Document covers an area located within the south east of Nottingham City Centre. The SPD sets out a vision for the future of the area, identifies constraints and opportunities and provides guidance on type, form and phasing of development expected on this site.

Any person with sufficient interest in the decision to adopt the SPD may apply to the High Court for permission to apply for judicial review of the decision. Any such application must be made promptly and not later than 3 months after the date on which the SPD was adopted.
