The **Sport and Leisure** are part of Nottingham City Council, who are the data controllers for the personal data (or personal information) that we process about you. When we process personal information relating to you, we will only do so when it is necessary and where we have a lawful reason to do so.

We will use the information provided by you for a number of reasons, depending on the service or reasons for interacting with you. This includes:

- Administrating of your Active Nottingham account,
- Processing your payment,
- Seeking feedback about our services,
- Providing information on products or services that you have requested from us,
- Keeping you informed about services, activities, events, membership offers and other opportunities available through our sports and leisure facilities.
- Ensuring the security of our facilities

When we process your personal information, we will comply with data protection legislation and enable you to exercise your rights contained within the legislation.

What personal information will the Council process?

The information that we collect about you to fulfil the purposes, objectives, or to deliver the services outlined above will relate to your: (this may include all, or some of the following, depending on the service).

- Name
- Address
- Contact details (telephone number and email address)
- Date of birth
- Gender
- Sports and leisure activities attended
- Membership number
- Video captured via CCTV

The information we process about you may include the following 'special categories of personal data':

- Race or Ethnic origin
- Physical or mental health

Lawful basis for processing

The basis under which we use your personal information for these purposes may be consent, that this is necessary for the performance of a task carried out in the public interest by the Council or in the exercise of official authority vested in the Council, for the performance of a contract to which you have entered into with the council or for legitimate interests, depending on the processing involved.

The condition under which we process 'special categories of personal data' is explicit consent, vital interests or that such use is necessary for reasons of substantial public interest in accordance with the provisions of the UK General Data Protection Regulation and the Data Protection Act 2018.

CCTV Monitoring

CCTV is in operation at our sports centres to ensure the safety and security of customers, staff and visitors; prevent and detect crime and anti-social behaviour; protect council property and assets and assist in the investigation of incidents, accidents and complaints in accordance with our [Privacy Notice for CCTV and Surveillance Cameras](#).

Will my information be shared with other organisations or used for other purposes?

The Council will only share your personal information with other departments within the Council, and with other organisations when it is necessary to provide the services to you, and when we have a lawful reason to do so. The Council may also share your information when we are obliged to by law.

We may engage with other controllers for you to access your health and fitness data, as necessary to provide core fitness and activity-tracking functionality.

The information may also be used for the purpose of any other function carried out by the Council. This may include sharing your information across the Council, or with external organisations. The information will only be used for another purpose where it is lawful to do so.

Do I have to provide the information?

You are not obliged by statute or contract to provide the information that is specified here. However, if we were not able to process your personal data we may not be able to offer you the services.

How long will the Council retain the data for?

The information that you have provided will be kept for 2 years according to the current Information Asset Register.

The Council publish an Information Asset Register (IAR), this will outline the retention periods for the personal data we process. You can find this IAR on our website <https://geoserver.nottinghamcity.gov.uk/information-asset-register/>

Information Rights

The UK General Data Protection Regulation provides for the following rights as prescribed by the legislation:

- A right to request a copy of your information
- A right to request rectification of inaccurate personal data
- A right to request erasure of your data known as 'the right to be forgotten'
- A right to in certain circumstances to request restriction of processing
- A right in certain circumstances to request portability of your data to another provider
- A right to object to processing of data in certain circumstances
- A right regarding automated decision-making including profiling

However, Nottingham City Council can restrict the above rights in certain circumstances for example to avoid obstructing an investigation, avoid prejudicing the prevention, detection, investigation or prosecution of criminal penalties or to protect the rights and freedoms of others.
