- preventing underage sales of alcohol
- preventing proxy sales of alcohol to underage persons
- preventing sales of alcohol to a person who is drunk.

These records shall be made available for inspection and copying by the Police and other officers of Responsible Authorities immediately on request and all such records to be retained at the premises for at least 12 months.

A bound and sequentially paginated refusals book or electronic record shall be kept at the premises to record all instances where admission or service is refused. Details to show:

- The basis of the refusal;
- The person making the decision to refuse; and
- The date and time of the refusal.

All such books/records shall be retained at the premises for at least 12 months and shall be made available for inspection and copying by the Police and other officers of Responsible Authorities immediately upon request.

A bound and sequentially paginated incident book or electronic record shall be kept to record all instances of disorder, damage to property and personal injury at the premises. All such books/records shall be retained by the premises licence holder for at least 12 months after each event and must be made available for inspection and copying by the Police and other officers of Responsible Authorities immediately upon request.

A Challenge 21 scheme shall operate at the premises. Any person who appears to be under 21 years of age shall not be sold/supplied alcohol unless they produce an acceptable form of identification (passport, photo driving licence, Military Identity card or PASS accredited card, or a similar approved version of a digital form of identification).

Challenge 21 notices shall be displayed in prominent positions throughout the premises.

Security Industry Authority door supervisors shall be employed at the premises on occasions as deemed necessary by the Designated Premises Supervisor and/or Premises Management following a risk assessment.

c) Public safety

The public safety objective has been considered in the light of the proposed premises. The proposed premises will not have an adverse effect on the public safety objective.
 The proposed premises will promote the public safety objective in accordance with the section 182 Guidance.
 The premises will operate in accordance with all relevant legislation which promotes the public safety objective including, but not limited to, the Health and Safety at Work etc Act 1974 and associated regulations, the Food Safety Act 1990, the Regulatory Reform (Fire Safety) Order 2005 and the Equality Act 2010.

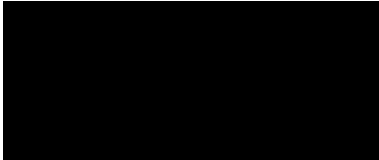

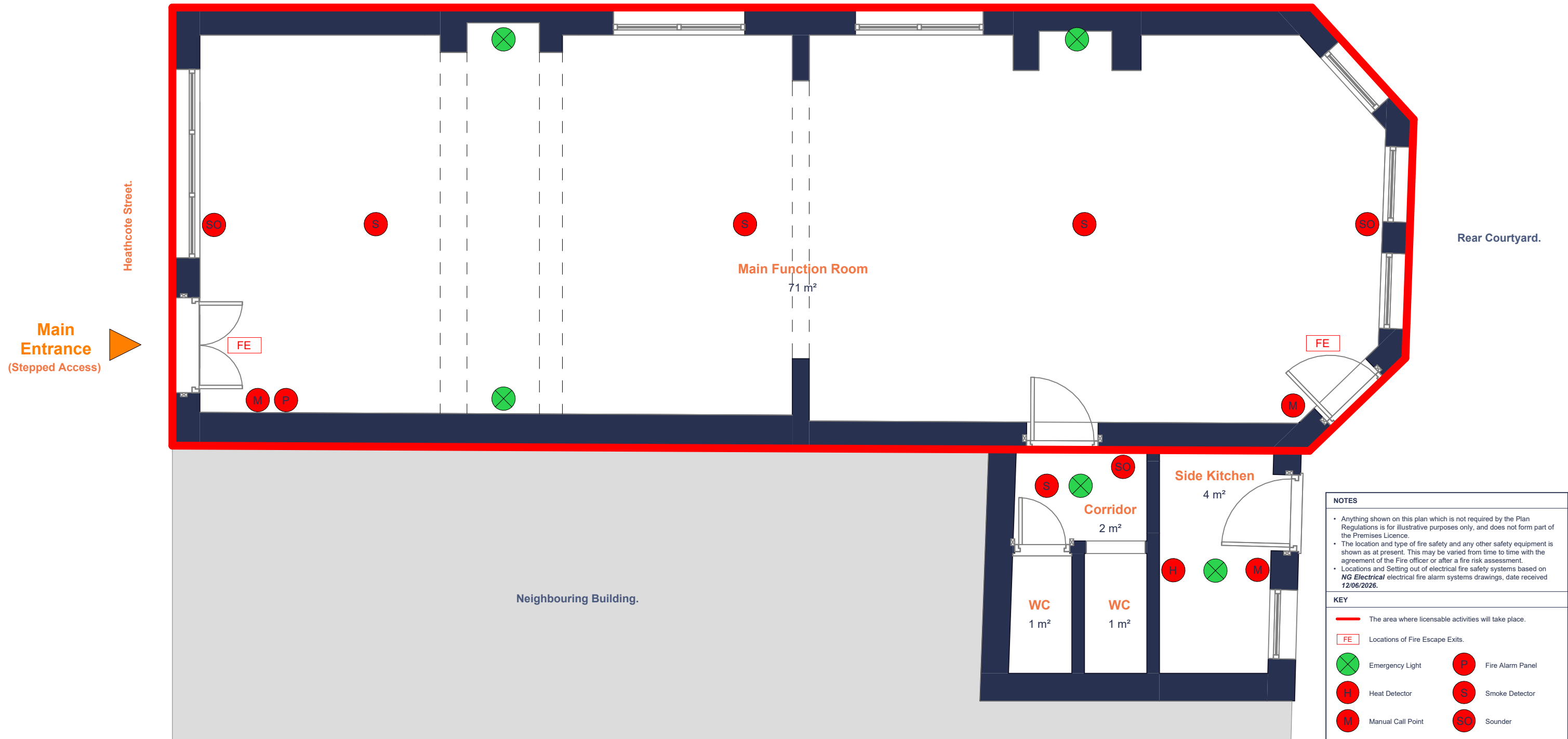

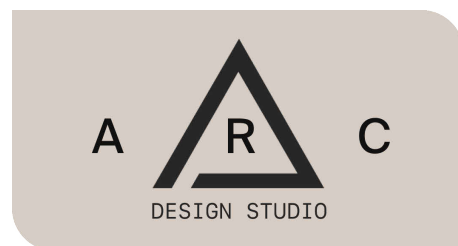
