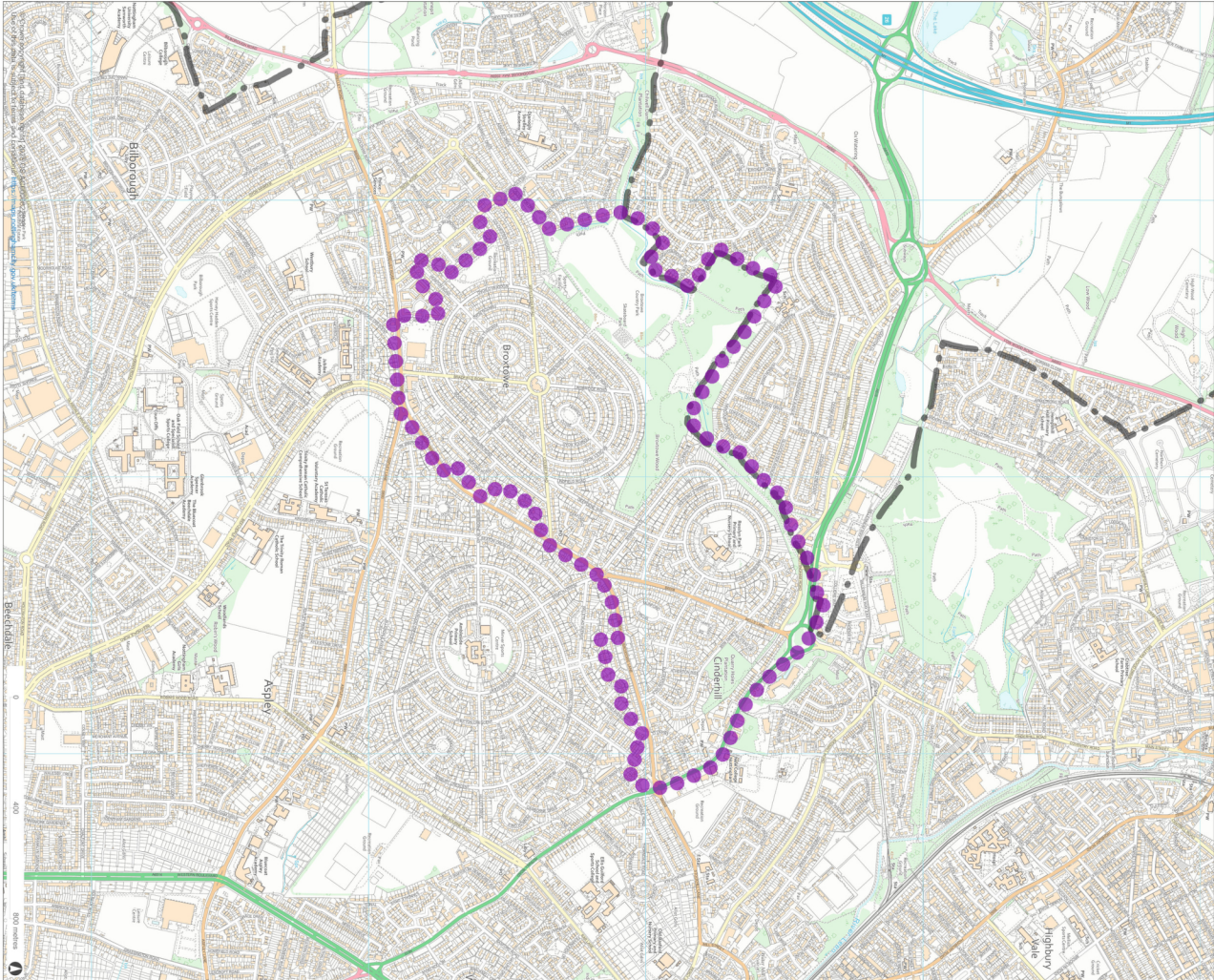

Proposed Pride in Place locality

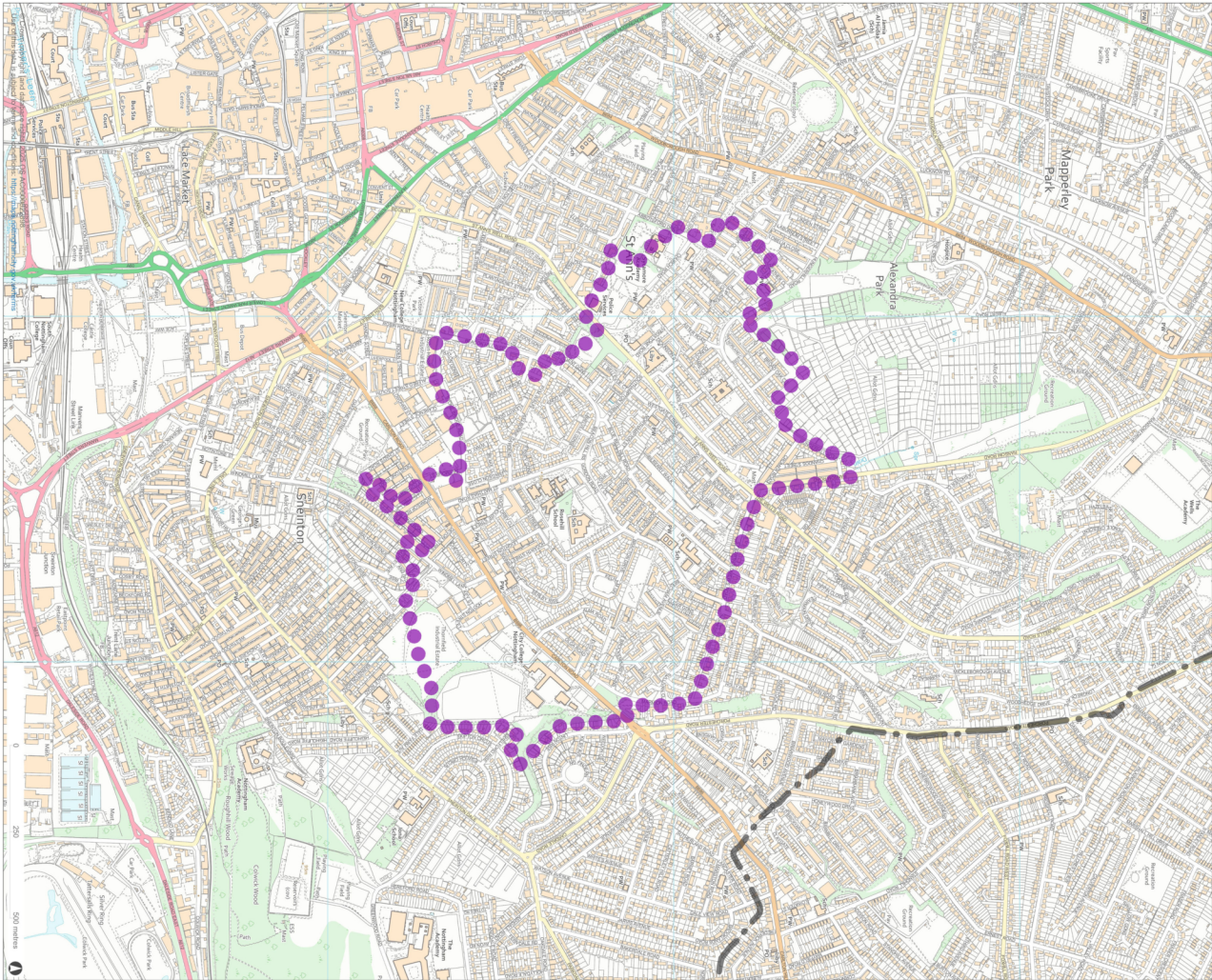
